### Admission Procedure:

Read and follow the following instructions before starting your online application

#### Step 1: Apply Online

- A. A candidate may apply for **three** Hons subjects and **two** General courses depending upon his/her eligibility. Please see **Eligibility** criteria before applying courses.
- B. **First, click on “ONLINE REGISTRATION” menu and fill up your personal information & academic details.**
- C. Get your **REGISTRATION ID AND PASSWORD** on your mobile.
- D. Click on **“APPLY ONLINE”** menu and log in using **REGISTRATION ID and PASSWORD (to be sent to your mobile no. and keep it for future use)** and select Hons & General courses for application.
- E. Modify personal & academic details if necessary and apply in your desired courses, upload scan copy of the Caste / PH certificate (for SC/ST/OBC-A&B/PH candidate) (within 200 KB) and HS mark sheet (within 200 KB) and finally submit the data.
- F. **To Pay Application Fees (Rs. 200/- for Hons and Rs. 100/- for General course)**  
Pay online at any time using Debit/Credit cards, Net banking, wallets, IMPS within specified dates (see **Important Dates**).
- G. Please **take a print out of application, payment receipt** and preserve it for future references.
- H. If you need any correction in the submitted form, please click on **“CORRECTION OF SUBMITTED FORMS”** menu and then rectify & submit.
- I. **Candidates are not required to submit any documents to the college.**
- J. Candidates applied for Honours/General Courses are requested to wait for publication of Merit in college website and college notice board.

### **Step 2: Steps to be followed after publication of Merit List**

- a) Final Merit Lists along will be displayed on College Notice Board and Website on the date notified.
- b) See **Online Counseling** for details (to be notified later on).

### **Step 3: What to do after payment of admission fees (Date of Activation of link for downloading Registration form will be notified later)**

- a) Log in using **APPLICATION ID and PASSWORD** and **upload your photo, signature and HS admit card**. Take print out of your application form and registration form.
- b) Printed Registration Form and Application Form (consisting Photo and signature of the candidate) with other requisite documents are to be submitted in college office on the stipulated date to get the **Roll No. with Fees Book, Temporary Library Card and Identity Card**.
- c) **Taking Roll no. on stipulated date is mandatory failing of which the candidature will be cancelled.**
- d) **Students, already enrolled in another College, should get their Admission cancelled from the previous college, before getting Admission (See Verification for details).**

### **N.B.**

- a) **The admission is provisional, subject to scrutiny and verification of the documents submitted.** The provisional admission is liable to be cancelled if student fails to submit documents required by the University. If admission of any such student is not approved by the University, she/he will not be entitled to any refund of fees.
- b) **Selection will be strictly on the basis of merit.**
- c) **It is assumed that the information furnished in the application is true to the best of the knowledge of the applicant. In case of any false / misleading information, the application will be summarily rejected.**
- d) **It is also assumed that the applicant is applying voluntarily on his / her own discretion without being influenced by any third party.**
- e) **The college authority reserves the rights of admission / rejection of any applicant without assigning any reason whatsoever.**
- f) In case of fraudulent activities / misconduct, observed even at a later stage, a candidate / student may be debarred from the college at the sole discretion of the College Authority and legal action may be initiated.

- g) 50% of fees (after admission) will be reimbursed to the person who are efficient in Cultural activities (having a certificate from Govt. Approved Academy) and, Sports activities (having a certificate of participation/medalist in Subdivision /District /State /National / International level).
- h) 25% of fees (after admission) will be reimbursed to the person who will participate in NCC and NSS.
- i) Classes for all female students admitted in 1<sup>st</sup> Year B.A. (General) course will be held in morning shift (from 8.00 A.M. onwards) and classes for all male students admitted in 1<sup>st</sup> Year B.A. (General) course will be held in the afternoon shift (from 1.00 P.M. onwards) and remaining Honors and General course student should attend class in day shift (10.00 A.M. onwards).
- j) The bank account is mandatory for all the students willing to take admission in our college.

## **Eligibility:**

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the Honours / General Course, **aggregate marks** shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate **provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.** However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/ Studies (ENVE) shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject “Environmental Science” is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

**Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. (General) only (without taking Education and Geography as combination subject).** Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational Examination in Business & Commerce conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.Com (General) course of Studies under this University.

The students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination in 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 2017 and 2018 are eligible for admission.

- a) Candidates who willing to take **Geography** as combination subject, must pass in **Geography** in H.S. (10+2) examination.
- b) Candidates who willing to take **Microbiology** as combination subject, must pass in **Biology/ Bio-Technology and Chemistry/ Physics** in H.S. (10+2) examination.
- c) Candidates who willing to take **Computer Science** as combination subject, must pass in **Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry** in H.S. (10+2) examination.
- d) Candidates who willing to take **Education** as combination subject, must pass in **Education/Psychology/Philosophy/Mathematics/Sociology/Economics/Political Science/History** in H.S. (10+2) examination.
- e) The students who were admitted in earlier sessions, but did not enroll for B. A. /B. Sc. (Pure & Bio)/B.Com. (Honours /General) Part I Examinations up to 2018 or the students who were admitted in earlier sessions and enrolled for B.A./B.Sc. (Pure & Bio)/B.Com. (Honours/General) Part I Examinations but did not appear in Part I Examinations up to 2018, can apply for readmission, but their merit index will be calculated as per rules notified in Merit Index calculation section.
- f) The students who were admitted in earlier sessions and appeared in B.A./B.Sc. (Pure & Bio)/B.Com. (Honours/General) Part I Examinations in 2018 or earlier, can't apply for readmission and shall continue to be guided by the existing Regulations of Annual System.

## **Merit Index Calculation**

### **For Honours Course**

- a) Merit-list of all honors subjects will be framed on the basis of **aggregate percentage of Best Four Marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of the subject marks opted for Honours** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.

### **For General Course**

- a) Merit-list of all **General Course** will be framed on the basis of **aggregate percentage of Best Four Marks (Except ENVE)** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- b) Merit List for **Computer Science** as Core Course subject will be based on **an aggregate percentage of Best Four Marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Mathematics + percentage of marks in Physics** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- c) Merit List for **Geography** as Core Course subject will be based on **an aggregate percentage of Best Four Marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Geography** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.

- d) Merit List for **Education** as Core Course subject will be based on **an aggregate percentage of Best Four Marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Education/Psychology/Philosophy/Mathematics/Sociology/Economics/Political Science/History** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- e) Merit List for **Microbiology** as Core Course subject will be based on **an aggregate percentage of Best Four Marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Biology/ Bio-Technology+percentage of marks in Chemistry/ Physics** obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- The students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination- 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018 are eligible for admission. But their merit index (i.e. percentage of Best Four marks and opted Honours subject marks (for Honours course) and percentage of Best Four marks (for General Course)) will be reduced @ 10 % for each preceding year i.e. 10 % marks will be deducted for the candidates who have passed the said examination in the year 2017, 20 % marks will be deducted for the candidates who have passed the said examination in the year 2016 and 30 % for the candidates of 2015 and so on. According to Calcutta University rules, **the candidates who have passed the HS or equivalent examination in the year before 2013 are not eligible for admission.**
  - The Compartmental or C.C candidates are also eligible for admission through online application. But their total marks will be reduced @ 5 % extra for each year of appearance in the said examination.
